**Random Lake Ambulance** — This service was started in 1980, and it's run by all volunteers of the Random Lake Fire Department. Although there is a charge for each conveyance, the money received from the United Fund is used to purchase new equipment and supplies, plus extra training for emergency medical technicians.

**Adell & Batavia First Responders** — These are run by both fire departments and moneys collected are used to buy needed equipment and help pay for training. These services provide valuable minutes before the Random Lake Ambulance arrives.

**American Red Cross** — Vital Red Cross work includes blood bank (which visits Random Lake twice a year), community health, disaster relief, swimming and lifesaving classes

**Visiting Nurses Association & St. Nicholas Home Health Care** — These two agencies provide in-home nursing care that enables people to remain independent within their homes. Fees are established based on ability to pay.

**Scouting program for our area** — Emphasis is on character building, citizenship training and mental fitness. Part of our money collected goes to support the general area councils: Bay-Lakes Boy Scout Council and the Manitou Girl Scout Council but most of our money collected is directed to strengthen our local units for both boys and girls.

**Friends of the Lakeview Community Library** — This is a volunteer support group that helps with projects and raises funds to purchase extra needed items and equipment.

**Random Lake Area Interfaith Food Pantry**— Provides help in terms of food to needy families to the southern half of Sheboygan County. Located at 310 Center Avenue, Adell. Open Tues. 9:00-11:30.

**Sheboygan County Mental Health Association** — Serves as a resource center for information, referrals educational programs and support groups.

**Arts Support Group of Greater Random Lake** — This agency brings performing artists into the community for school workshops and public performances.

**Adell & Random Lake Center for Senior Citizens** — The Sheboygan County Office on Aging coordinates activities and nutrition programs which is open to all senior county residents, located at 510 Seifert St., Adell, 920-994-9934.

**Camp Riversite 4-H camp** — near Hingham, is an educational nature camp as well as semi-recreational, with approximately 1 1/2 miles of nature trails. It is open to the public and school groups as well as 4-H clubs.

**Family Connections, Inc.**— A child care resource and referral agency serving all of Sheboygan County. Provides information to parents regarding child care options, and education to the public regarding quality child care. Call 1-800-322-2046.

**Family Resource Center of Sheboygan County** — Trains volunteers who will work on a one to one basis to help those interested in improving their literacy skills. Call 920-892-6706.

**Sheb. Co, Interfaith Org. Bridgeway Project** — Sheboygan county's only transitional shelter for the homeless, providing the bridge to a new life thru education and mentoring.

**Big Brothers & Big Sisters of Sheboygan County.** Matches caring, responsible adults to single-parent community children to form friendship relationships. This simple "one-to-one" formula has a dramatic effect on the positive maturation of the child.

**Sharon S. Richardson Hospice & Palliative Care** — 20 bed residence is the first hospice center in Sheboygan County. Also provides in home palliative care dedicated solely to meeting the needs of the terminally ill.

**Safe Harbor of Sheboygan County** — Established in 1990, facility is the only domestic violence shelter in Sheboygan County. Women and their minor children who stay at the 18 bed shelter are provided with room and board at no cost. Men may also receive services, but do not stay at the shelter.

**Medical College of Wisconsin** — is our national academic research center. Research priorities include cancer, cardiovascular, digestive, genetics, and neuroscience diseases.

**211 phone number** — provides free non-emergency confidential information and referral. Call 2-1-1 for help with food, housing, employment, health care, counseling and more.

**Campaign and Administration Costs** — To cover costs incurred by the United Fund of printing and postage. All United Fund officers and workers serve as volunteers. Less than 4% of all money collected covers expenses.
